(i.e. from Novotel, Fairmont, Trade Centre)

- Take Um Hurair Road leading to Maktoum Bridge
- Turn Right on Street 9a (Signs towards Lamcy Plaza/American Hospital/Movenpick)
- Straight onto Al-Nasr Cinema Roundabout
- Take the first right from Roundabout (onto Street 2)
- Take the first left onto Street 11a
- Ismaili Centre Dubai is on your right side

Coming from Sharjah, Deira Side of Dubai or Airport

- Take Garhoud Bridge towards Sheikh Zayed Road
- Prior to Lamey Plaza, take the service lane for petrol station and ENOC building
- Take exit after ENOC building and go straight until the Al-Nasr Cinema Roundabout
- Take the third right on the Roundabout (onto Street 2)
- Take the first left onto Street 11a
- Ismaili Centre Dubai is on your right side
